All documents allowed; duration : 1h 30. The four exercises are independent one of each other. **Exercise 1** (5 pts) Let us recall the rule  $\lor_{\ell}$  of LK :

$$\frac{\Gamma, A \models \Delta \quad \Gamma, B \models \Delta}{\Gamma, A \lor B \models \Delta}$$

Is this rule *reversible*? i.e. does LK admit the two following derived rules? :

$$\frac{\overline{\Gamma, A \lor B \models \Delta}}{\overline{\Gamma, A \models \Delta}} LK \qquad \frac{\overline{\Gamma, A \lor B \models \Delta}}{\overline{\Gamma, B \models \Delta}} LK$$

## Exercise 2 (5 pts)

1- Give a proof, within system LK, of the sequents :

$$\neg (A \land (B \lor C)) \models (\neg A) \lor ((\neg B) \land \neg C)$$
$$\neg (A \land \exists x \ Q(x)) \models (\neg A) \lor \forall x \ \neg Q(x)$$

2- Give a proof, within system LJ, of the sequent :

$$(\forall x P(x)) \land (\exists y Q(y)) \vdash \exists y (P(y) \land Q(y))$$

## Exercise 3 (5 pts)

Let us recall that MO is a set of axioms for the theory of monoids (see the special sheet about sets of axioms). Let us consider the sequent S:

$$\mathrm{MO} \models \forall x \ \forall y \ \exists z \ x = y * z$$

1- Build a model for this sequent.

2- Build a counter-model for this sequent.

3- Is the sequent S provable within LK? within LJ?

## Exercise 4 (5 pts)

Let us consider the following Kripke structure  $\mathcal{K} := (K, \leq, | \vdash - _0)$ , over the propositional signature consisting of two predicate symbols A, B of arity 0:

 $K := \{0, 1, 2\}$ , the partial ordering over K is defined by  $0 \le 1, 0 \le 2$  and the initial forcing relation is  $||-0| := \{(0, A), (1, A), (1, B), (2, A), (2, B)\}$ .

1- Determine whether, in this structure :  $\begin{array}{c} 0 \mid \vdash -A \lor \neg A ? \\ 0 \mid \vdash -(\neg \neg B) \to B ? \end{array}$ 2- Determine whether :  $\begin{array}{c} \vdash_{LJ}A \lor \neg A ? \\ \vdash_{LJ}(\neg \neg B) \to B ? \end{array}$
